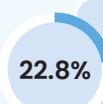

22.8% of adults in the United States are experiencing at least one mental illness this year. That represents over 50 million people or almost 1 in 4 adults.

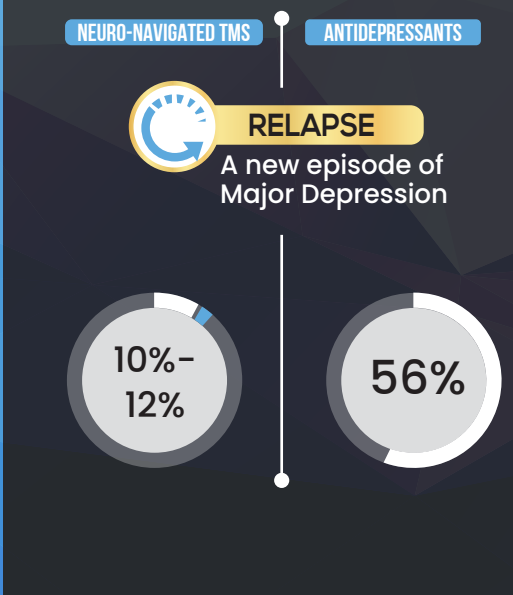
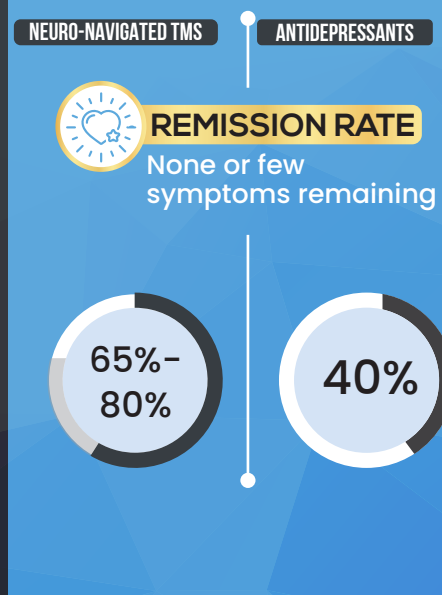
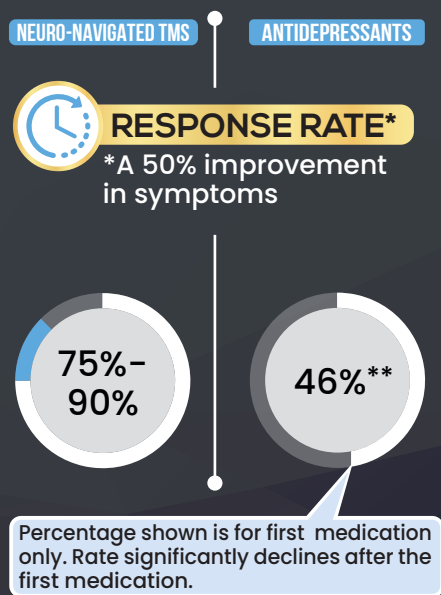


1 in 20 U.S. adults suffer from a serious mental illness. More than 50% of adults with Major Depressive Disorder are not receiving any treatment

46 percent of Americans will meet the criteria for a mental health condition sometime in their life, and half of those people will develop a condition by the age of 14.



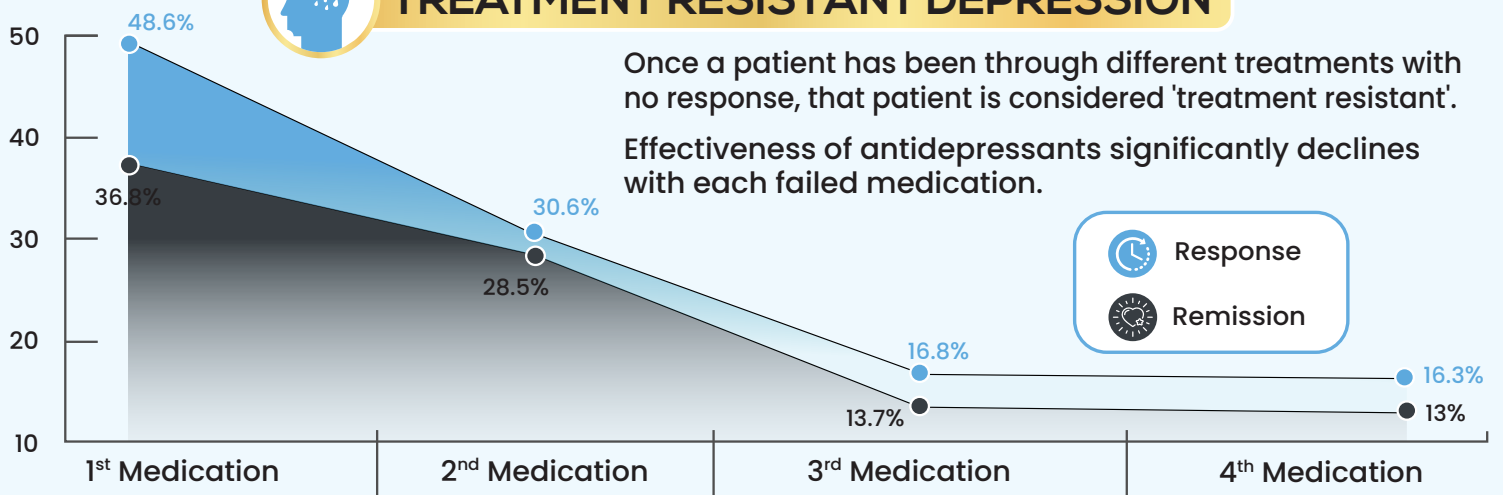
Symptoms of Depression: Loss of pleasure, overwhelming sadness, changes in appetite, disrupted sleep patterns, extreme fatigue, feelings of guilt and worthlessness, suicidal thoughts.



TREATMENT RESISTANT DEPRESSION

Once a patient has been through different treatments with no response, that patient is considered 'treatment resistant'.

Effectiveness of antidepressants significantly declines with each failed medication.

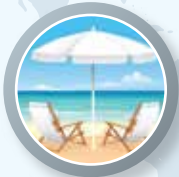
